ABSTRACT

Consumption pattern of individuals has been observed to differ widely. It differs by community, sex, place of residence, economic status, occupations etc. It is one of the most important macro variables that determines the aggregate demand for goods and services in the economy. The study finds that the expenditure of the student and their parental incomes are positively related while there is marginal difference in the consumption pattern of the students of the rural and urban colleges.
