ABSTRACT

It aims at reaching the absolute truth in the form of conclusion reviewed by many critics through intellectual discourses in the different disciplines of studies. This may be the concrete perception of the author which cannot be made dead in the actual analysis of the text. He is to be studied at a certain point of objectivity in the text. The mystic knowledge which is not accessible for the textual analysis is studied through transdeconstruction.
