In order to properly combat the Covid-19 pandemic, the central government has released an incentive package of Rs 20 lakh crore, which seems to be 10 per cent of GDP. The government will provide Rs 1 lakh for other schemes, Rs 10,000 crore for food and Rs 20,000 crore for fisheries and animal husbandry, according to Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. The present
