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PAST, PRESENT, FUTURE: A CHRONOSYNCRACTIC INFUNDIBULUM OF REALITIES AS REPRESENTED IN THE SELECTED WORKS OF KURT VONNEGUT JR.



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ABSTRACT

Kurt Vonnegut's Slaughterhouse-Five or The Children's Crusade: A Duty Dance with Death is a dystopian novel that has changed American fiction into such a way it has really retraced understanding of War literature. More than placing war and state as the heroes the author tells the reader as the world being caught up in a chronosyncractic Infundibulum, a kind of a snare in which the human race has been caught in. Vonnegut uses several devices, several places both original and fictional, usurps the time – space continuum and places the reader along with the characters in a system which keeps going backwards and from which there is no escape. This paper is an attempt to study some of the devices and features used by Vonnegut in his narration.
